- Achieve and exceed annual fundraising targets, with a focus on securing major gifts, grants, donor acquisition and retention campaigns, and planned giving.
- Set clear priorities and focus appropriate time and energy to meet strategic goals and deadlines.
- Prepare the annual fundraising plan budget.
- Remain current on all legislation, ethical practices and trends; ensures all gifts are recorded and acknowledged in accordance with applicable state and Federal laws, FASB Standards and hospital code of ethics.
- Consult with appropriate staff to identify/address opportunities and/or risks.
- Collaborate with other departments to integrate fundraising goals and initiatives into the overall organizational strategy.
- Assist in the promotion of the organization's brand, including developing marketing and public relations materials.
- Assist in the identification of relevant grant opportunities and submit material and applications as required.
- Maintain effective long-term relationships with existing donors, prospects and board members.

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The Candidate

The ideal **Director of Development** will have experience in the building and execution of multi-faceted revenue generation programs. The candidate's experience will include the establishment of growth targets for a wide variety of outreach and communications channels; and the continual and creative expansion of a major donor pipeline.
