This position establishes and ensures compliance with appropriate accounting and financial policies, procedures, and practices, and safeguards VPM's assets.

### **Key Responsibilities**

#### **Financial Strategy & Planning**

- Partner with the CFO and organizational leadership to develop multi-year budgets, forecasts, and scenario analyses aligned with strategic goals
- Assist the CFO in developing, documenting, and ensuring compliance with accounting policies, procedures, controls, and best practices
- Attend VPM Finance and Audit Committee, and VPM and Foundation Board of Directors meetings

#### **Financial Reporting & Analysis**

- Provide monthly financial reports including:

- Compile daily and monthly internal management reports
